

Welcome to Logan County's very own riding stables! English and Western riding options are available on trails through 450 acres of fields, woods, hills, and streams. Marmon Valley is named for one of the first families to settle in the county in 1806. Dr. James Marmon is known as the only doctor willing to treat cholera victims during the outbreak in the 1840's. He died of it in 1849. 37 miles from Sidney.
