Here's What You'll See:

Opened in 1972 by the Ohio Historical Society, and named in the honor of Wapakoneta native astronaut Neil Armstrong, the museum chronicles Ohioans' contributions to the history of flight and new horizons in space travel including the space shuttle program and the International Space Station. See a moon rock and the Gemini VIII spacecraft. The museum's Astro Theater presents the sights and sounds of space. Recent renovations include the addition of interactive exhibits with a space shuttle landing simulator and a lunar landing simulator. 21 miles from Sidney.
